- State and local advocacy

- Training and education

What are Long Term Services and Supports?



- Assistance for older adults and people with disabilities to help with everyday self-care tasks (e.g. feeding, bathing, dressing, toileting)
- Can be provided in institutions or at home
- Among people age 65 and over, an estimated 70 percent will use LTSS
- \$310 billion per year
- Medicaid is the main payer
 - Shifting to managed care

What are Long Term Services and Supports?



Bill

- 56 years old
- Spinal cord injury with resulting paraplegia
- Recurrent pressure ulcers
- Frequent hospitalizations for infections
- Lives independently

Examples of Services:

- Personal Care Attendant hours
- Specialized wheelchair, air mattress, lift, ramps
- Transportation

Alice

- 90 years old
- Worsening dementia
- Multiple chronic illnesses
- Frequent falls
- Widowed, lives with daughter who works full-time

Examples of Services:


- Home health aide
- Day program
- Transportation
