

Research and Program Assistant (Full-Time Position)

This position will work closely with the Academy team on several major projects and provide direct support to the CEO.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Work closely with the CEO, including providing project management, scheduling, and other types of program and administrative support.
- Conducting policy research and providing research assistance to ongoing projects.
- Assembling, organizing, and synthesizing research, writing, and feedback (e.g. on a Task Force report).
- Writing and editing for research briefs, reports, publications, and other Academy content.
- Supporting Academy events and programming.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Self-starter, strong organizational skills, strong project management skills.
- Strong research and writing skills; research experience in a related field a plus.
- Eager and able to quickly learn about new subjects and to juggle multiple deadline-driven assignments.
- Collaborative work style and team player; comfortable providing support to group projects.
- Comfortable working closely with and providing support to a senior nonprofit leader.
- Commitment to social insurance; familiarity with relevant programs a plus.
- Undergraduate degree in a relevant field; master's degree preferred.
